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Hello,

My Coaches Corner Internet Instruction session is an exercise to get teachers doing practical investigation for their content areas using the Internet. This program is suitable for anyone using the Internet in his or her teaching activities and has two paths for completion. The first is guided using four core content areas as starting points. The second is self-directed. Both may be adapted to suit your specific need. I've enclosed the information for both versions.

In the guided path we have chosen four major content areas for your consideration. This path is designed for someone with no Internet skills and gets into browsers and various activities. There is a book that leads you through the activities that you can acquire for each of the content areas from <http://www.amazon.com> or another source. The web site activities from the book cover K-12, but many participants find their own sites more specifically suited to their classroom needs. To complete the assignment you research 15 web sites.

The second path is self-directed and you explore 15 websites of your choosing that will accommodate and fit your needs. This path assumes someone with basic Internet skills with common browsers and tools like Google. My role is to monitor and verify your work and share my experience in completing this exercise.

In both cases the final project requires investigating and reporting on 15 websites. Individual submissions vary depending on how they intend to use the content in the classroom. For some this is a literacy exercise for others it is curriculum development. You complete the project at your own speed, but generally most participants complete easily in part of a weekend.

To complete the project, organize your report, submit it to me for verification. I then contact CCS that you have successfully completed the exercise and email you the registration form. You then contact CCS and submit the registration form with tuition payment. Once the tuition is paid, credit is granted.
